

A. Install LabSim from the Internet

1. Click the following link:
<http://www.testout.com/support/download/LabSimOnlineSetup.exe>
2. Select “Run” to install immediately.
3. The install wizard will guide you through the installation process.

B. Log In

Your instructor has already created your LabSim account and associated it with your campus and class. After your instructor gives you your login ID and password, you can log in.

1. Launch LabSim.
2. When the Login screen appears, enter your login ID and password.
3. Click “Login.”

C. Your LabSim Account and Courses

Even though your instructor created your account, you can update your personal information at any time. After logging in:

1. Click the “Settings” link from the My Account section in the LabSim navigation panel.
2. You can change your personal information such as login, password, first and last name, and email address.

Any LabSim courses that have been activated for your account should appear on your LabSim home screen.

D. Navigate Courses

LabSim displays in two panels: the navigation on the left and the LabSim content on the right.

The LabSim home screen displays the list of courses that have been activated for your account. To launch a course, click the course’s title.

Standard and **Outline Views** are available for the LabSim navigation panel. You can switch back and forth between the views at any time.

Standard View shows you only the contents of the section you select. Then:

- Select a specific resource by clicking the item title.
- Use the up arrow to move up in the tree of contents.
- Use the **Next** and **Previous** buttons located at the bottom right of LabSim to access the sections directly before or after the current section.

Outline View shows you the navigation panel using an expanding folder approach.

- Click the small arrow next to a section to expand or retract its contents.
- Select a specific resource by clicking the item in the tree.
- Use the **Next** and **Previous** buttons located at the bottom right of LabSim to access the sections directly before or after the current section.
